- 3&4 foot
- 5,6 Triple forward at right angle R, L, R
- 7&8 Step forward at left angle on Left foot, step forward at right angle on Right foot

Triple forward at left angle L, R, L

Cross Rock, 1/4 Turning Side Shuffle, Jazz Box

- 1,2 Cross rock Right foot over Left, recover Left
- 3&4 ½ turn right side shuffle R, L, R
- 5-8 Cross Left over Right, step back on Right, step side Left, touch Right (man behind lady)

- 7&8 Shuffle forward L, R, L
